

Thank you for your interest in our Happy Dogs training course!

Please read through the following Frequently Asked Questions, which should give you all the information you need but if you do require further information, please don't hesitate to contact the office: 0845 269 26 27.

How long are the courses?

The initial Happy Dog Training course is 6 weeks. Jez runs a number of courses which compliment the progression including fun agility.

How old does my dog need to be?

Dogs of all breed and all ages are welcome. If your dog is younger than 18 weeks old, the Puppy Training course would be more suitable.

Where are the courses held?

Jez runs courses in various locations throughout Buckinghamshire, Berkshire and Oxfordshire. For details of the next course dates at a location near you, please email: courses@jezrose.co.uk. On booking, we'll send you a pre-course checklist and directions.

What time is the course?

To accommodate demand, we run both daytime courses on a Saturday and evening courses on a Tuesday evening. Each week lasts one hour.

How much does the course cost?

£150 for the full 6 weeks. This includes refreshments, a training clicker and dog training booklet. Payment is required on booking by cheque, PayPal, credit card or cash on your first week. Part attendance is not possible.

Do I need to book or can I just turn up?

The training courses and private consultations are always oversubscribed due to Jez's demand so please book early.

How many people will there be on the course?

Jez is renowned for providing high quality training without compromise and as such numbers are restricted to a maximum of 10 dogs per course. Owners are encouraged to bring anyone that will have regular contact with the dog where possible.

What happens each week?

The first half an hour is an ideal opportunity to relax, grab a drink and allow the dogs to socialise and play supervised by Jez and his team... it's great fun to meet the other dog owners, too!



Jez's style is relaxed, fun and non-violent at all times. You get a full hour of contact and teaching time with regular structured play sessions to maintain the dog's attention. Each week finishes with a fun competition with prizes for the best dog!

You'll learn how to observe, handle and train your dog to give you a strong foundation on which calm and well-behaved dogs grow. In no time at all, compliance will become a simple matter of dog preference as your dog learns to listen to you because that's what they want to do.

There are no presentations or lectures; the entire course is guided instruction by Jez, assisted by his team and will cover:

- A basic introduction to canine psychology and Jez's Canine Connection principle
- Dog health including diet and needs
- The "sit" position
- The "down" position
- The "stand" position
- The "stay" cue
- The "leave it" and "give" cues
- The "heel" cue
- Recall (getting your dog to return to you when you call it!)
